*Eternal rest grant unto him O Lord and may perpetual light shine upon him. May he rest in peace. AMEN.*



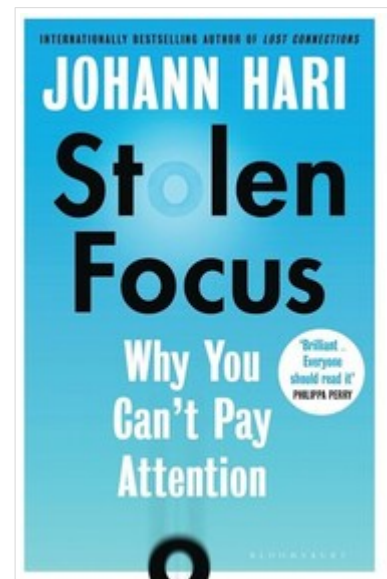

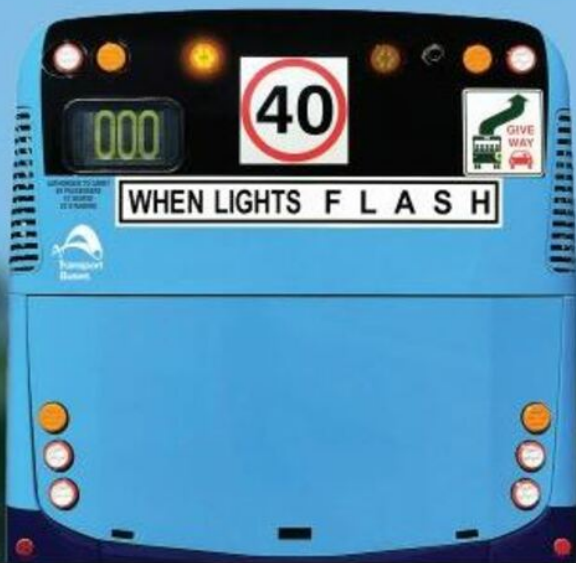
